### DURATION

24 months full time residential programme commencing from July 2018.

### PEDAGOGY

PGDM-ABPM (approved by AICTE) offers a range of sector-specific courses to meet the requirements of industry. The faculty carefully craft curriculum and develop effective Assurance of Learning (AoL) resources and best practices for student learning. The classroom sessions are supplemented with lecture, video, seminar, group work, role-play, cup tasting (sensory test), field & industrial visit, study abroad and guest lecture.

### ELIGIBILITY

The minimum qualification for admission is a Bachelor's Degree from a recognized university or institution with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (45% in case of SC, ST and Persons with Disability) in agricultural and allied sciences or any other discipline. NRI / PIO / Foreign students can also apply.

### PLACEMENT

Placement record has been bright and attractive. Graduates of the Institute are placed in leading agribusiness and plantation companies within the country and in African and South East Asian countries. Nearly 44 students are serving in abroad in agribusiness plantation companies.
